She was born 14 February 1840 in Neustadt, perhaps Schleswig-Holstein (now Germany)^{6,7}, and died 16 August 1914 in Kellogg, Jasper County, Iowa, buried in German Lutheran Cemetery, Kellogg, Iowa⁸.

His full name was Johann Ludwig Wilhelm Block; came to the US on the Senator Iken, November 1865 - January 1866 (from Ralph Brien).

Notes for Louisa Hintz:

Her full name was Louisa Friderica Wilhelmina Hintz; came to the US on the Senator Iken, November 1865 - January 1866 (from Ralph Brien).

(Hintz)² Block (Lewis¹)¹⁹ was born 6 March 1860 in Wredenhagen, Mecklenburg-Schwerin (now Mecklenburg, Germany)^{19,20,21,22,23,24}, and died 7 August 1944 in Clackamas County, Oregon, buried in Sandy Cemetery, Sandy, Oregon^{25,26}. She married **Henry Hamman**²⁷ 3 March 1877 in Jasper County, Iowa²⁸. He was born 1849 in Mecklenburg (now Germany)^{29,30,31,32}, and died 23 September 1928 in Clackamas County, Oregon, buried in Sandy Cemetery, Sandy, Oregon^{33,34,35}.

Her name at birth was Augusta Johanna Maria Hintz; came to the US on the Senator Iken, November 1865 - January 1866 (from Ralph Brien).

Notes for Henry Hamman:

Henry probably immigrated to the US in 1869 on the bark Argonaut, arriving in NY on 31 August 1869 (per Ralph Brien). The 1900 US census says he immigrated in 1868 while the 1910 US census says 1870.

I think Henry married Mary Grimm on 9 Sept 1873 in Iowa County, Iowa, and that she was the mother of Henry's 1st 2 children, but that has not been confirmed.

E-mail message from Katherine to me in October, 2002;

"I don't have your email address so hope that this gets to you. I remember Anna Connelly just barely but there was a daughter who we used to go and see in Mason City. Dad was fond of her. I know nothing of my Dad Block's background really as it was all Maytag as I grew up. I am 86 now so there are lots of stuff I don't recall for sure. I remember going to Oregon to visit Aunt Augusta. Outside of the Briens that I met I have nothing to help you with. I was adopted at the age of 2 and my biological family lived in the area and so in my later years I have been in touch with them and kept up that connection. My mother died when I was 2 and that is when Mother Block and Dad Block took me in and gave me a good home. Sorry I don't have any information to help you that I know about. As ever - Grandma Kate".

She married **Robert James Connelly** 29 August 1903 in Tiffin, Johnson County, Iowa¹⁶⁸, son of Peter Connelly and Melinda Dunlap. He was born 15 July 1879 in Keokuk County, Iowa^{169,170,171,172,173}, and died 7 January 1943 in Mason City, Cerro Gordo County, Iowa, buried in Elmwood Cemetery, Mason City, Iowa¹⁷⁴.

Notes for Anna (Druhl) Block:

Anna's birth date is given as 10 June 1884 on her death certificate; the informant was her daughter Dorothy. It is given as 10 June 1885 by her son Roy. I think she was born in 1886 as that is the year of death on the gravestone of her birth mother Dora (Schultz) Druhl and Roy Connelly said that Anna was born just 20 days before her birth mother died. Dora (Schultz) Druhl's death date is given as 19 June 1886 in the obituary of her husband James Druhl so this leaves some doubt about the day and month of Anna's birth.

Whether Anna was ever officially adopted by Lewis & Louisa (Hintz) Block is questionable. When Louisa's estate was probated, Anna was not an heir.
