She was born 9 March 1813 in Puttsee, Fehmarn Island, Schleswig-Holstein, Germany, and died 18 November 1883 in St. Jurgens, Fehmarn Island, Schleswig-Holstein, Germany.

Notes for JURGEN CHRISTOPHER DRUHL:

According to the records on the Island of Fehmarn, Christopher changed his name to Druhl after the birth of his first child. The original surname was Danish and he felt more accepted on the island with a German sounding name.

The widow Margaretha Drühl born Kröger of the St. Jürgens Hospital and Church. She was in Petersdorf on Sept 4 1839 married in the name of Margaretha Kröger. The Jochim Kröger and the not known in Gollendorf daughter. The Petersdorf confirmation was in 1828 in the name of Talke Margaretha. The farmhand Jochim Matthäus Kröger in Petersdorf legal daughter. She was born March 9 1813 in Petersdorf and listed in the baptismal records as Tebbel Hedwig the daughter of the Working man Jochim Matthäus Kröger and Gertrud born Wilkens in Püttsee. Born March 9 1813. (this next line I am unable to understand, they mention 8 months and 9 days and then they say born on March 16 1816 in Petersdorf. I checked this day in the Petersdorf book and found no birth records. It's as if they are speaking of a conflict in the records)

On Sept 4 1839 married the working man Jürgen Christopher Drühl of Heiligenhafen who died on March 4 1853. She has three living children in North America. 1.) Carl Drühl born June 8 1842 in Davenport a farmer married to a Schumann of Dänschendorf. They have 5 living children. 2.) Joachim Drühl born Nov 16 1847 by Davenport a farmer married to Dorothea Schulz also known as Schuldt. They have 5 living children. 3.) Gertrude Drühl born April 5 1852 by Davenport married to Holsteiner with 5 living children.

Obituary of Carl Druhl (Davenport Democrat, Davenport, IA, 1/28/1918, Monday, page 11, submitted by

Thomas Lisco.):

Stricken with paralysis while shoveling the snow off the sidewalk in front of his residence, 821 West Seventeenth street, Carl Druhl, pioneer Scott county resident, died at 8 o'clock Sunday morning. His death was a great shock to his relatives and friends. Mr. Druhl was born in Insel Fehmarn, Germany, May 14, 1842. He came to the United States and to Clinton in 1865 and two years later was united in marriage to Miss Gertrude Schumman. In 1868 the couple came to Scott county, settling on a farm near Pleasant Valley, where they lived until 1915. They have made their home in Davenport for the last three years. Mr. Druhl is survived by his widow and four sons, Henry, Charles, John, Emil and Herman. One sister, Mrs. Henry Drossel, lives in Stockton, Ia. There are 11 grandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 1 o'clock Wednesday afternoon from the home, 821 West Seventeenth street.

(Note by RRC: Here his surname is given as Druhl; several - but not all - of his children spelled the name Druehl; here his birth date is given as 14 May 1842; from Fehmarn records provided by John Kostick it was 8 June 1842; here it says he was survived by four sons, then lists five sons; five is correct; I suspect "Schumman" should be Schumann.)

Mrs. Gertrude Druhl, 81, died today at 10:15 a. m. at the home of her sons, Herman and Emil, R. R. No. 5 after a lingering illness.

She was born in Insel, Fehmarn, Germany, July 14, 1845 coming to this country and to Clinton county in 1868. That same year on June 8 she was married to Carl Druhl. After farming in that county for two years the couple moved to Scott county living on a place on the Jersey Ridge road until 13 years ago when they retired. The Druhls counted scores of friends in both counties where they had made their home.

Surviving are four sons, Henry, John, Emil and Herman, ten grandchildren and eight great grandchildren. Mr. Druhl preceded his wife in death Jan. 27, 1918.

The funeral will be held Saturday at 1 p. m. from the late home. Burial will be in Fairmount cemetery.

(Note by RRC: Here her married name is given as Druehl; several - but not all - of her children spelled the name Druehl but I suspect she used Druhl; I suspect "Insel, Fehmarn" should be Insel Fehmarn which means Fehmarn Island; here her birth date is given as 14 July 1845; from Fehmarn records provided by John Kostick it was 2 July 1845.)

He married (1) DORA 'DORIS' SCHULTZ 1 December 1873 in Scott Co., IA¹⁷, daughter of JOHN SCHULTZ and KATHRINA DETLOFF. She was born 1852 in Holstein, Germany, and died 19 June 1886 in Kellogg, IA, buried in German Lutheran cemetery, Kellogg, IA¹⁸. He married (2) DORA SANGEROL¹⁸ 1888 in Jasper Co., IA¹⁸. She was born 1841, and died ca 1914 in _____, buried in _____ cemetery, Shelby, MT¹⁸.

1891: Went to Cerro Gordo Co., IA, (Cerro Gordo County History, 1894, as reported by Kent Gossman).

1895: Resided in Genesco Township, Cerro Gordo Co., IA, enumerated with wife Dora and children Amanda, Emiel, Maggie, Melia, Kata & Emma (Iowa State census).

1900: Farmed in Bath Township, Cerro Gordo Co., IA, living with 2nd wife Dora and daughters Katie and Emma (US census, ED 17, page 5, family 92).

James Druhl obituary (Shelby IA newspaper, unknown date, transcribed by Roger R. Connelly in 2002 from a photocopy submitted by Kent Gossman):

OBITUARY

Jim Druhl was born in Fehmarn, Germany, November 12, 1851, and passed away at the home of his

daughter in Shelby, Iowa, January 29, 1916, at midnight, being sick but three days of pneumonia, at the age of 64 years, 2 months and 17 days.

Deceased came to Davenport, Iowa, and was married to Miss Dora Schultz in 1872. To this union seven children were born, one of whom died in infancy. Later they came to Kellogg. His wife died on June 19, 1886.

In 1888 he was united in marriage with Miss Dora Sangerol, one child being born to them. They then moved to Minnesota.

Since the death of his second wife about two years ago he has made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Alfred Normand, at Shelby, Iowa.

The remains were brought to Kellogg last Friday, and on Saturday afternoon funeral services were held at the German cemetery, where interment was made.

He leaves six daughters and one son to mourn his death, all being present at the funeral excepting three. Those present were Mr. and Mrs. Alfred Normand of Shelby, Iowa; Mrs. Amanda Hammond of Omaha, Nebraska; Mrs. Amelia Pederson of Benson, Nebraska; Mrs. Katie Arndt of LeGrand, Iowa; and one brother-in-law, Mr. John Schultz of Chicago, Illinois. (Note RRC: day of death should be 23; year of first marriage should be 1873; Normand should be Norman).

Information on James Druh's birth date is not consistent: born 12 November (obituary), 1851 (gravestone and obituary), in Fehmarn (obituary), Holstein, Germany (1880 US census). Kent Gossman gives his birth as 23 November 1849 in Fehmarn, Holstein, Germany. It is 23 November 1850 on his death certificate where the informant was Alfred Norman, his son-in-law.

Late 1870s-early 1880s: Children born in Jasper Co., IA (1885 Iowa census).

1880: Farmed in Mariposa Township, Jasper Co., IA, lived with husband James, daughter Amanda, son Amil, and daughter Minnie (1880 US census, ED 91, page 4, family ?).

1885: Resided in Jasper Co., IA (1885 Iowa census).

1886: Died 19 June (her husband's obituary) 1886 (that obit & her gravestone), probably in Jasper Co., Iowa.

Greg Goebel has a photo of his great-great-grandmother, Dora (Schultz) Druhl (1852-1886), which was taken in Burg, a city in Fehmarn, Germany (the name of the photography studio and this location is

stamped on the back of the photo). Dora appears to be in her late teens or early 20's in the photo, so it was probably taken around 1870. Greg sent this information to John Kostick who compiles family groups based on his work with Fehmarn Island church records (fehmarngenealogy.com). John equates Dora Schultz with Dorothea Margaretha Schultz, child "ii" in the following family:

Fearing That He Would
Become Paralyzed, Man
Ends Life by Hanging

Fearing that frequent strokes would result in his entire body becoming paralyzed, Charles Druehl, 54, a farmer living four miles east of Davenport ended his life at 7 o'clock this morning by hanging. His body was discovered half an hour later by his son, Leonard, hanging from a rafter in the hayloft.

According to members of the family, Druehl had been despondent for some time over his ill health. It is believed that the frequent strokes effected his mind.

This morning while carrying several milk pails to the basement of his home, he suffered a stroke that resulted in one of his arms becoming partially paralyzed. After resting a while he went to the barn and helped his son with the morning work.

The son, Leonard, left his father in the barnyard shortly before 7 o'clock, telling him that breakfast was ready. Druehl told him that he would come shortly. The family, becoming worried over his absence, started a thoro search of the buildings. The body was found by a son hanging from one of the beams in the hayloft. A halter rope was used.

Coroner Cantwell was immediately summoned and pronounced death due to hanging. The body was removed to the Runge undertaking parlors.

Druehl was well known in this vicinity. He was born in Scott county and had many friends thruout the county. He spent nearly his entire life in the county farming.

Deceased was born Feb. 16, 1869, in Lincoln township, Scott County, Iowa.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Laura Druehl, and three daughters, Mrs. Dora Joern of Davenport, Mrs. Freda Watkins of Pleasant Valley and Miss Anna, at home. Two sons also survive. Hugo and Leonard, both at home. His mother, Mrs. Carl Druehl, and four brothers, John of Buffalo, Iowa, Henry of Maysville, Elmer and Herman, on the Harrison street road are among the survivors.

Funeral services will be held from the home Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, with interment in Fairmount cemetery.

(Note by RRC: I think the brother "Elmer" should be Emil.)

The most specific information I have found on the birth dates of Charles and his brother Henry comes from their obituaries, 24 Mar 1869 for Henry and 16 Feb 1869 for Charles. But it is doubtful that they were born in different months in the same year; I suspect that the birth year given for Charles in his obituary is incorrect. In the 1880, 1895, 1900, 1910 & 1920 censuses, Henry is age 11, 25, 31, 40 & 50, respectively, and Charles is age 10, 24, 30, 40 & 49, respectively; Henry is one year older than Charles in all but one of these censuses. In 1900, the birth month and birth year is given as Mar 1869 for Henry, Feb 1870 for Charles; I have assumed these are correct.)

Amiel Druhl, 48, wellknown Minot contractor, died at 4 o'clock this morning at a local hospital. Mr. Druhl was operated upon for appendicitis on July 8, and was apparently recovering satisfactorily so that his death came as a great shock to his family and friends. Complications set in suddenly and he began sinking at 11 o'clock last evening.

Norman and Arndt have already wired that they will be here for the funeral.

Mr. and Mrs. Druhl were married in Minot in 1908 and went immediately to a farm 60 miles west of Estevan, Can., where they made their home for seven years. Before his marriage Mr. Druhl was foreman for the George Kemper Construction company and nine years ago he left the farm with his family and came back to Minot to live, buying a partnership interest in the Kemper firm. He was in that company until the time of his death.

Mr. Druhl had been in active charge of the firm's interests in Minot, while Mr. Kemper has been engaged in similar busines in California. When Mr. Druhl was taken ill, Mr. Kemper returned to Minot to look after their joint interests, and he will remain here for an indefinite time.

JOHN HORN DEAD

Prominent Bartlett Township Farmer Succumbed Sunday Evening

John Horn, the well known and highly respected farmer of Bartlett township, died Sunday evening after a sickness covering six months to a day. Mr. Horn was first taken sick in January and was shortly after taken to the Brainerd hospital where his trouble was diagnosed as Hodgkins disease and while there was no known cure for this ailment, at times his condition was so much better that relatives had much hopes that he would ultimately recover. On the day of his death he was bright and cheerful and had partaken of a hearty meal, but along towards evening there was a sudden change for the worse and the end came so sudden that it was a sever shock to the members of his family and other relatives who were present.

The funeral was held Wednesday afternoon from the German Lutheran Church of Bartlett township. Rev. Struber, of Bertha, officiating and the burial was made in the cemetery at that place. That the diseased was well thought of in the community where he had resided for several years past was attested by the large number of friends and neighbors who were present at the funeral and followed the remains to their last resting place.

Mr. Horn was born in Germany in 1865 and was therefore 46 years of age. He came to America in 1888 and settled in Scott County, Iowa. He removed to Bartlett township about 12 years ago and settled on the farm which has since been his home. Mr. Horn was married in Iowa 17 years ago to the lady who with five children, two girls and three boys survive him. Besides his family, two brothers, Martin and Henry Horn and two sisters, Mrs. Ben Umland and Mrs. Jake Umland, all prominent residents of Bartlett, are left to mourn the loss of a kind and loving brother. The aged mother and one sister still reside in Germany. Mr. Horn was one of the progressive farmers of the community and a hard worker. At the time he was stricken with the disease which he made a long and determined fight to conquer, he had began to realize some of the fruits of his long years of hard work and was so situated that he could take life a little easier, but an all-wise providence seems to have ruled otherwise and although suffering intense pain at times, he never complained of his misfortunes and carried his usual happy smile to the last.

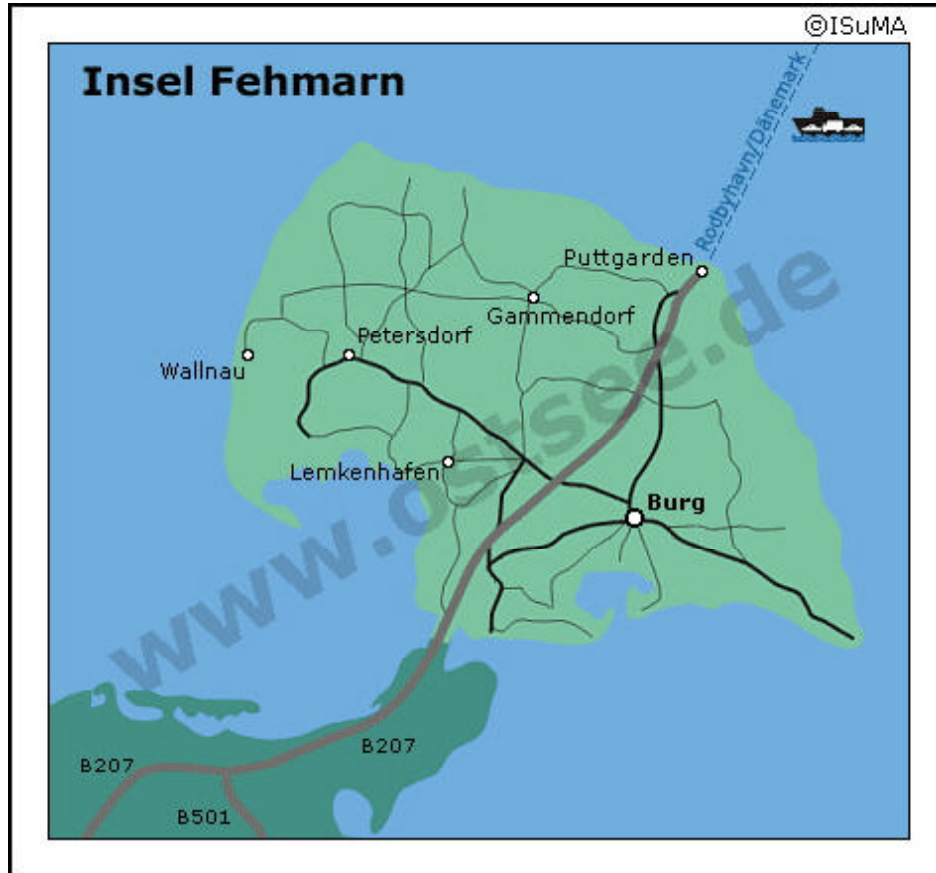

(hand written by my uncle Roy in 1974, updated by him in the late 1970s, transcribed from a copy of the original in 2002 by me, Roger R. Connelly. I have privatized Roy's work by replacing some dates with XX, XXXX.)

My name is Roy Elmo Connelly, born February 14, 1919 in Mason City, Iowa. After serving in World War II I attended Iowa State College at Ames, Iowa. Since 1949 my employment has been in Oil Exploration as a Geophysicist. My present address is 4950 Savoie Court, New Orleans, Louisiana, 70129. Marjorie Love Blanks and I were married in Laurel, Mississippi, April 21, 1946. Marjorie was born November 3, 1918 in York, Alabama and she passed away on August 19, 1973. She is buried in Toomsaba, Mississippi near Meridian, Mississippi where her parents Elizabeth and Clyde Blanks (both now deceased) resided.

We have two sons, Michael Robert Connelly, born October XX, XXXX in Ames, Iowa and Richard Clyde Connelly, born November XX, XXXX in Lubbock, Texas. Mike graduated from Louisiana State University Law School in June, 1973 and is now an attorney in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He married Marilyn Memory in New Orleans, La. on August XX, XXXX. They now have a son, Sean Michael Connelly, born April XX, XXXX in Baton Rouge, La. & 2nd son, Patrick Devlin Connelly, born _____. Their present address is Baton Rouge, La. Rick is presently attending U. of Houston, Houston, Tex.

Beginning here your editing for corrections and your additions are requested. In some way, I've been told, Nancy Hanks, wife of Abraham Lincoln is related to our family. Does anyone have old letters or knowledge of this portion of our ancestry?

My parents were Anne Block Connelly (adopted by the Block family), her real parents were the Druhl family. My mother Anne Block Connelly was born June 10, 1885 near Newton and Kellog, Iowa and died in 1946 in Mason City, Iowa, where she is buried. Her mother, Doris Schultz Druhl died when Anne was about 20 days old and her Father, James Druhl did his best to take care of her. It was a hardship for him and the Blocks offered to take care of her as a baby. Anne's Father married for the 2nd time and Anne was returned to the Druhls. Mrs. Block had become so attached to Anne that she became ill so the Druhls consented to let the Blocks raise my mother, Anne. Mother had one sister Kate (Kathryn?) Druhl Arndt, born November 2, 1882 and died November 7, 1954.

My Mother's other sisters and brothers were Amanda Druhl Hamand, born probably in the same Druhl home near Kellog, Iowa and died and was cremated (about 55 years ago) in Omaha, Nebraska. She had one daughter, Eva Ham (& Heine) living in Omaha when last heard from. Amanda had a twin brother who died when he was a year old. Then came Amiel Druhl, born probably in the same home. He died (about 50 or 52 years ago) in Minot, North Dakota. He had two sons Morris Druhl and _____. Also, he had on daughter named _____ (Virgie). She was last known to be in Portland, Oregon. Next in line was Millie (Mildred?) Druhl Pederson born in the same

home near Kellogg, Iowa (lived in Omaha, Nebraska) and died (about 1957). She had two sons Harry Pederson and _____ Pederson plus one daughter who was killed by an Auto in San Francisco, California. Last of my mother Anne's full blood sisters was Margaret Druhl Norman born in the same house and she died (about seven years ago in November). She had four sons. The oldest, Howard Norman, died in a tractor accident in _____ (same month that Millie's daughter was killed in California). The youngest son, named Arthur died (about 27 years ago). The other two boys are named Harold Norman and Ralph Norman. Ralph, at least, is still living.

As a personal note, I believe my Aunt Margaret's husband was named Alfred. I still bear a scar the length of my big toe caused when I tried to be a good boy and chop some kindling wood at their home. Wasn't it in Shelby, Iowa? I remember beginning kindergarten at school wearing no shoe on my right foot due to the size of the bandage, and the kids laughed at me. Also, if my childhood memory serves me correctly Aunt Margaret and Uncle Alfred on one visit to us on the farm, northeast of Mason City, drove up in a large shiny new car which Uncle Alfred was a novice driving. To preserve the shine on the car he requested that he put it in the garage. My father consented and Uncle Alfred proceeded; driving in the open front door then out through the back wall. I'm almost certain Dad expressed "some" annoyance over losing our half of the garage.

Most of this information about my mother's family was provided by Aunt Emma, Mother's half-sister. She was most considerate in writing a long letter about everyone but herself. Aunt Emma Hubbs was born in 1889 in the same house at Newton, Iowa as Anne, my Mother, and Aunt Kate. She is reasonably certain the others listed were born there, also. Aunt Emma now lives in Silver City, New Mexico.

Harold Block has provided some information on the Block family. He lives at 4811 40th Lane, Minneapolis, Minnesota, 55416. We need as much data on Harold's parents (Louis & Anna Kay Block), grand-parents (who raised my Mother) and immediate family as he, and others, can provide. Harold's father had two blood sisters. One, named Louise, married Owen Brien (I can vaguely remember him), a conductor on the Rock Island. They lived in Rock Island, Illinois. The other sister, Augusta, married a man from Kellogg and they lived in Oregon. Harold remembers my parents lived in Tipton, Iowa, before I was born, and went rabbit hunting once with my Dad. From Harold I learned that Augusta's husband was named Henry Hammond. Both are deceased but have living children in Oregon. The Briens, both deceased, had two sons Ed and Owen Jr., both deceased, and a daughter, Nellie, who lost her husband, and has three girls. Harold's wife is named Lila; she was seriously ill in 1969 but pulled through after four major operations. Harold and Lila have lived in Minneapolis for twenty-five years where Harold sold Real Estate for a good many years until his retirement in 1969. In the back of my memory is the idea that Harold was Police Chief in Marshalltown, Iowa when I was a boy.

On my Mother's side of the family I presently have more data (but not yet complete) Aunt

Kate than any others. This is due to closer proximity to them plus the information provided by Ted and Margaret Arndt who presently reside at 203 1st Street, S.E., Nora Springs, Iowa 50458.

Kate Druhl was married July 10, 1900 to Fred Arndt born February 3, 1878 and died January 15, 1961. As a little boy I can remember visiting Aunt Kate and Uncle Fred on their farm near Blue Earth, Minnesota. When I was very little their geese hissed at me, and chased me. I loved Aunt Kate and Uncle Fred but hated their damn geese.

Aunt Kate and Uncle Fred Arndt's family is as follows. Son Laurence born June 23, 1901 and died April 14, 1972. Mrs. Laurence Arndt lives at 1503 Rainier Avenue, Everett, Washington, 98201. Eva Arndt, daughter - I can remember her but have no information about her. Son Clarence Arndt born June 26, 1905, present address is Route 1, Blue Earth, Minnesota 56013. Clarence married Blanche Fallert on June 7, 1932. Blanche was born September 7, 1910. Clarence and Blanche's children are Marlene, born February XX, XXXX. She married Ralph Saxton on June XX, XXXX and born to them were Kevin Todd Saxton on April XX, XXXX and Michelle Lynn Saxton on June XX, XXXX. Son Weldon Arndt born February XX, XXXX, married Bonnie Blom, September XX, XXXX. Their children are Scott Alan Arndt, born December XX, XXXX and Kimberly Sue Arndt, born October XX, XXXX. Mildred Arndt was born December XX, XXXX and married Marlene Dodge, May XX, XXXX. They have one son, Jeffrey Mildred Arndt, born November XX, XXXX. Next in line for Clarence and Blanche was Dale Arndt, born April XX, XXXX and married to Phyllis Bidwell, April XX, XXXX. Jerold Arndt, born April XX, XXXX, married Vivian Winters on October XX, XXXX. Jerad Wray Arndt was born to them on July XX, XXXX. Janice Arndt was born April XX, XXXX and married to Gary Philipp on June XX, XXXX. Their children are Kelly Jo Philipp, born July XX, XXXX and Kari Beth Philipp, born March XX, XXXX. Last of Clarence and Blanche's children is Gary Arndt, born April XX, XXXX and married to Margaret La Clare on November XX, XXXX. Their children are Lana Marie Arndt born September XX, XXXX and Bobbie Jo Arndt, born April XX, XXXX.

Next born to Aunt Kate and Uncle Fred Arndt was Ted Arndt on April 23, 1907. He was married to Margaret Nelson on January 19, 1934. Margaret was born February XX, XXXX. Ted and Margaret's family began with Phyllis Jean Arndt, (a favorite of my wife Marjorie in Mason City, Iowa in 1946) born December XX, XXXX. Phyllis was married August XX, XXXX to Tom Kelley and he was born March XX, XXXX. Phyllis and Tom's children; Michael Edward Kelley, born June XX, XXXX and Michael married Glennis O'Donnell who was born April XX, XXXX. Phyllis's second child is John Thomas Kelley, born January XX, XXXX. The second of Ted's children is Morris Melvin Arndt, born February XX, XXXX. Morris lives at Rt. 2 Portland, (Mason City) Iowa. Next in line is Ted Arndt, Jr., born May XX, XXXX. Ted Jr. married Beverly Fish, September XX, XXXX. Beverly was born May XX, XXXX. Their children are Randi (sp?) Lynn, born June XX, XXXX, Pamela Jean born February XX, XXXX, Brenda Lee, born February XX, XXXX and Penny Marie, born March XX, XXXX. Ted Jr., and

family, live at Nora Springs, Iowa. Harold Lee Arndt was the next of Ted Sr. and Margaret's children. He was born October 1, 1938, but passed away December 22, 1967. Harold was married March 1, 1958 to Judy Bradbury, born December XX, XXXX . Their children are Kathy Jo, born September XX, XXXX , Harold Allen born June XX, XXXX and Annette Marie born August XX, XXXX . Marly (sp?) Ann Arndt was born September XX, XXXX . She married Richard Senere (sp?) on September XX, XXXX . Richard was born July XX, XXXX . Their children are Richard Anthony born March XX, XXXX , Terry Lee born March XX, XXXX and Tammy Sue, born June XX, XXXX . Marly (sp?) divorced, then married Jerry Kramm, born July XX, XXXX , on April XX, XXXX . They have three children, Kelly Marie, born March XX, XXXX and twin sister Kimberly Mary, also born March XX, XXXX . Their third child is Christopher Steven, born May XX, XXXX . Marly and Jerry reside at Stillwater, Minnesota. Peggy Jean Arndt, born March XX, XXXX , was married to Jerry Majeuiski (sp?) on August XX, XXXX . Jerry was born July XX, XXXX . Their children are Jodi Ann, born January XX, XXXX and David Joseph, born June XX, XXXX . Peggy and Jerry live at Evansdale, Iowa. Ted, Sr. and Margaret had a baby girl Katherine Lou Arndt born August 28, 1956 and only lived for a day; she died August 29, 1956. Reminds me of the epitath on the tombstone of three week old baby girl in England. The epitath reads "It was so soon I was done for, I wonder what I was begun for." However, I read somewhere in the Bible that God said, "I am doing a work in the world and even if I told you, you wouldn't believe it." Last but never least of the children of Ted Arndt Sr. and Margaret is Bruce Allen Arndt, born May XX, XXXX . Bruce lives at home with his parents.

We still have some descendents of Fred and Kate Arndt to hear from and get record of such as Mrs. (Eva) Herman Tesch, North Gorman St. or Ave., Blue Earth, Minnesota 56013, Mrs. Duane Gossman, Thompson, Iowa 50478. Mrs. Gossman is Glen Arndt's oldest daughter. Also, there is Lillian and Buck Arndt. Personally, I'd like to hear directly from all the people listed in this compilation and to become acquainted with as many as possible. In an old address book of mine are the names of Bob Workman, 216 - 6th Avenue, S.E., Olwein, Iowa and Hazel Workman, Dubuque, Iowa.

This is all I have on my Mother's family as of June 18, 1974. Your help on yourself, your family and others will be appreciated. Use these copies as work sheets if you desire; thats what I intend to do - write between the lines and on the back. The final record will be re-written and perhaps put into a more satisfactory format. Do you want a copy of it?
